



CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GUESTS

Camping is limited to,

- friends and family of our members who agree to sponsor them.
- members of Barbershop Harmony Society (BHS), Sweet Adelines International (SAI), or Harmony Incorporated (HI).

Upon arrival campers are to go directly to their assigned lot as previously given to them, and text Lori Armstrong, Camping Coordinator at 905-441-3289.

The absolute maximum speed at Harmony Ranch is 15 km/hr. Main roads south of the pond are one-way roads and those north of the pond are two-way roads.

The maximum permitted on one camp site or vacant lot is:

1. One trailer/vehicle on wheels for camping **or** two tents
2. One dining tent.

Only one vehicle is allowed to park on the camping lot at any given time. Additional vehicles should be parked in one of the designated parking areas. The Camping Coordinator should have received all license plate numbers, before arrival.

Only one electrical outlet is to be used.

All camping sites will have a backflow preventer (vacuum breaker) installed. You must keep your hose attached to this backflow preventer at all times. Please do not remove this backflow preventer when you leave. If you have any questions, please ask the Camping Coordinator.

Guests are requested to keep their campfire gatherings quieter after midnight. Even good quarteting after this time can be considered “noise.”

Campfires may only be lit in designated fire pits. Whenever a fire is burning, you must have either a large bucket of sand or water, or a fire extinguisher nearby.

All pets should remain on a leash or otherwise secured, unless they are in a fenced area or at the Off-Leash Dog Park. Excessive noise from barking, fighting, etc. is unacceptable. Guests are expected to clean up their pet droppings immediately.
